31.5 inches long, with a wheelbase of 14 inches, or  
31.81 inches long, with a wheelbase of 14.2 inches.

## P1 - Mellow Kicktail

The mellow tail provides more control when popping the board, and thus requires less leg energy. The low tail gives you more consistent air and flip tricks, which makes for longer days of shredding.

## P3 - Steep Kicktail

Steep profile kicks provide superior pop for learning and performing flat ground tricks. However, this requires using greater force with your back foot to pop tricks.
